Assembly instructions

NECESSARY TOOLS

B&W Printer

Scissors or a cutter

Hole Puncher

15 square feet of leather

Thread and needles

8 Buckles and a few rivets









PRINTING THE PATTERN

Set up your printer to A4 paper with no margins on landscape mode.


Alternatively you can use "letter" format which is approximately the same size and will not impact the size of the product





Print your patterns. Cut out all the parts and paste them as shown in the picture below.

For the straps you will need all the pieces shown to the right. The rivets should be set according to the number and letter codes. The video will show the entire process



Use these templates to cut the leather and make the stitching holes. As always with any of my patterns EVERY STITCHING HOLE is precisely placed and necessary. The more accurate you mark them and make them the better the stitching will be
