NECESSARY TOOLS

B&W Printer



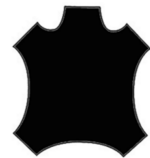
Scissors or a cutter



Hole Puncher



Approx 16 square feet of leather



Thread and needles



7 x 20 mm Buckles and a few rivets

PRINTING THE PATTERN

Set up your printer to A4 paper and check “actual size” box.

Alternatively you can use “letter” format which is approximately the same size and will not impact the size of the product significantly

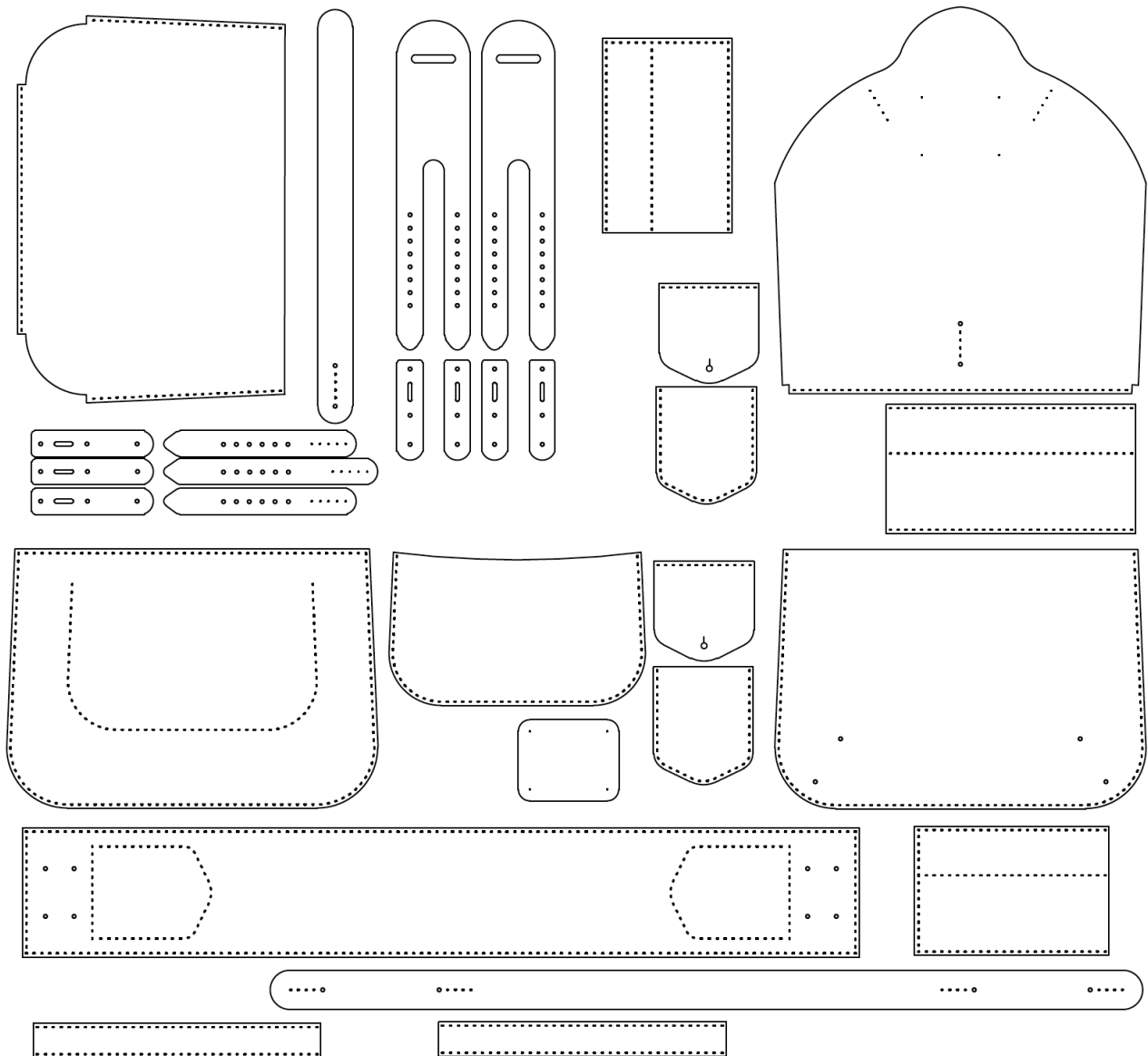
