

BOULES BAG



Assembly instructions

Difficulty level: Beginner
Completion Time 6 - 8 hours

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NECESSARY TOOLS

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B&W Printer



Scissors or a cutter



Hole Puncher (We recommend 1.8 - 2 mm sized holes for this build)



Approx 3.5 square feet of leather. (We recommend 6 - 7 oz leather for this build)



Thread and needles (We recommend 1.2 mm waxed thread for this build)



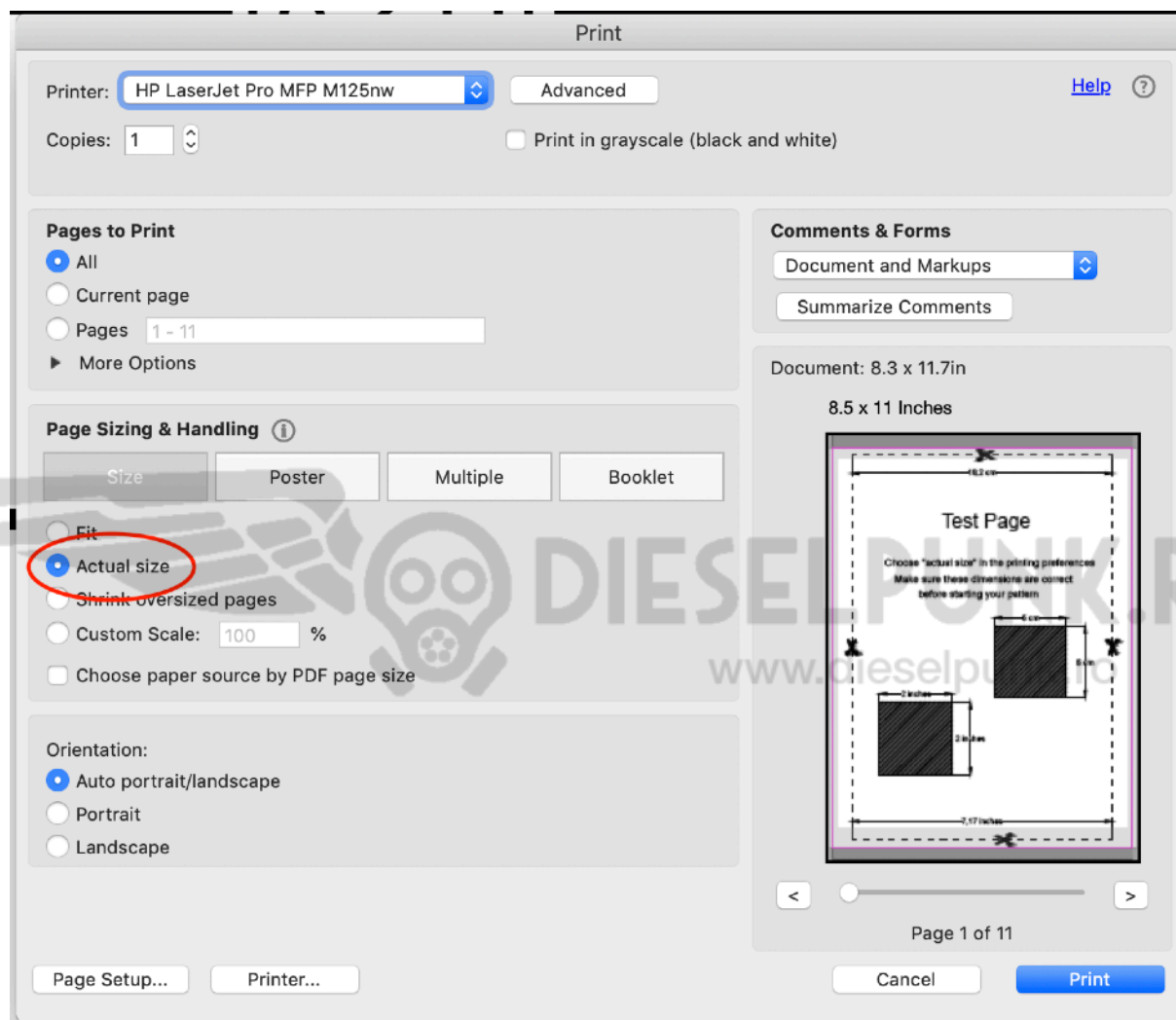

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PRINTING THE PATTERN

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Set up your paper size to A4 and choose actual size in the printer settings

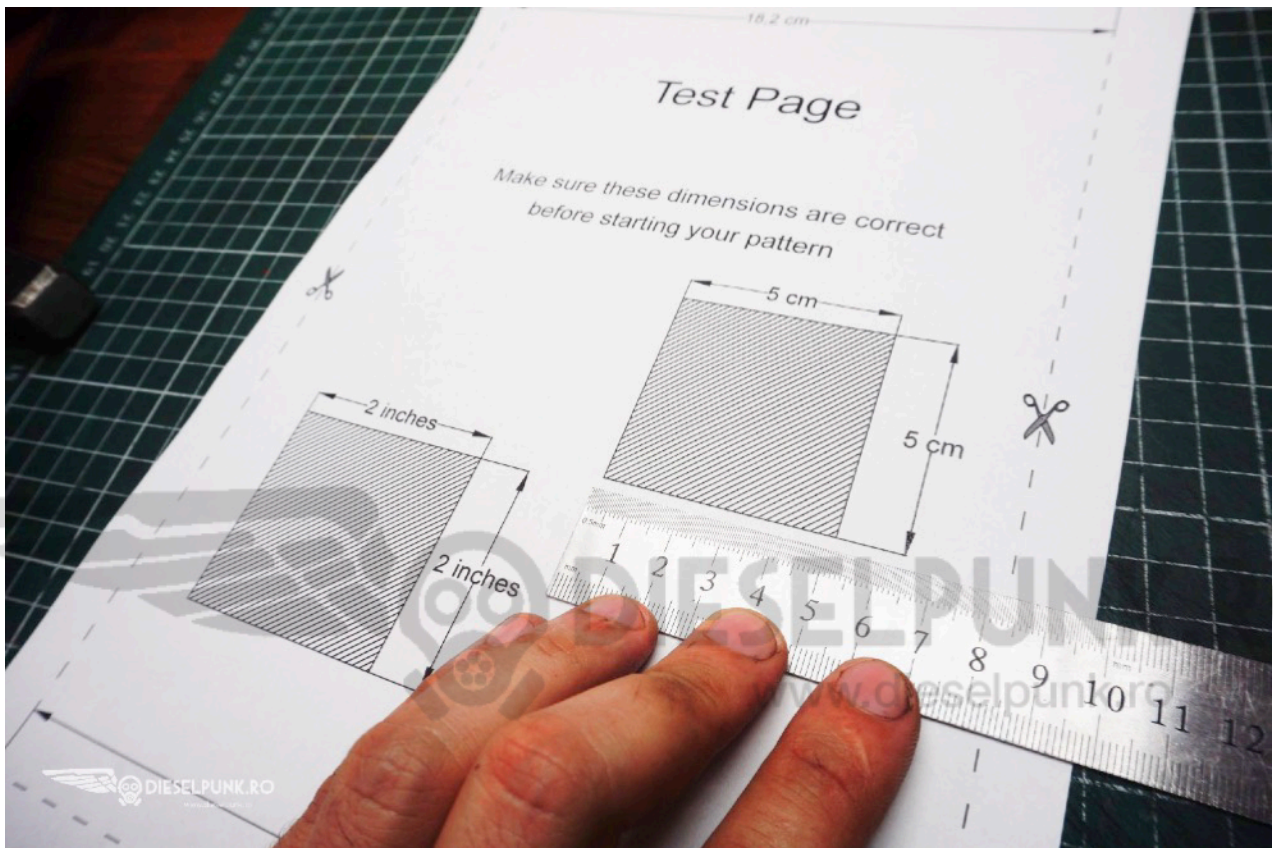


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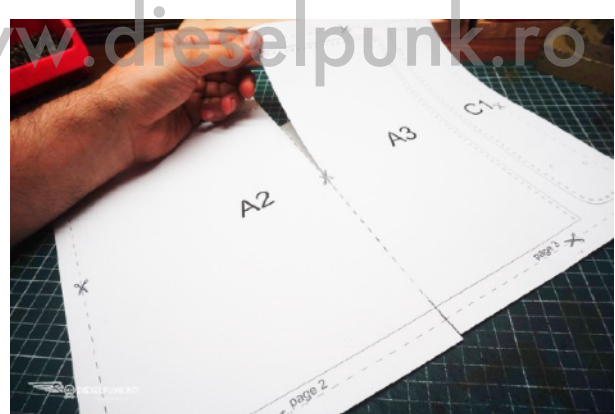
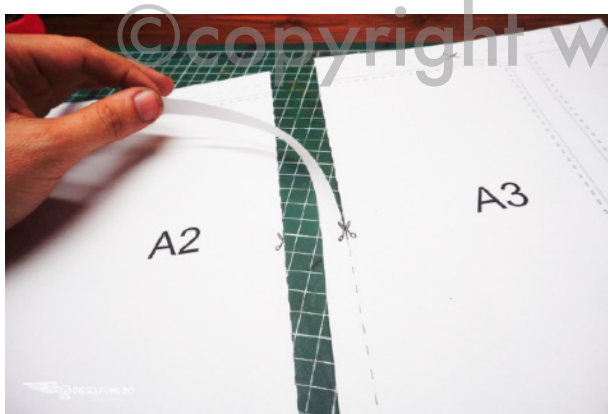
Alternatively you can use "letter" format which is approximately the same size and will not impact the size of the product significantly

Print all the patterns found at the end of this document.

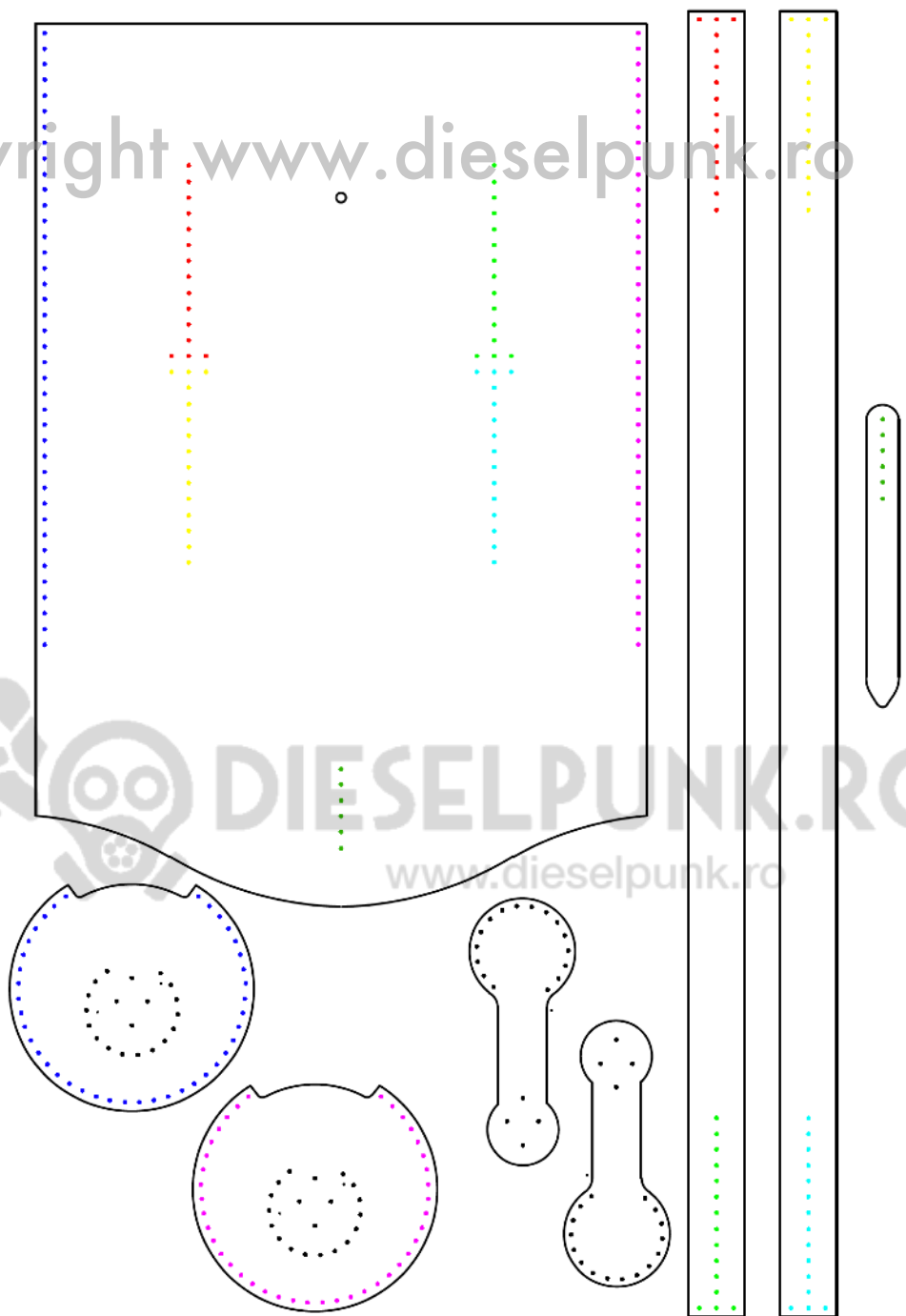
The first page is a measuring reference and you can use a ruler to make sure it matches the square. That means the rest of the pattern will print on the right size



Take note that the large piece is spread over four pages.
Use the second page of the pattern as an assembly guide
Cut out the edges and use only the inside of the page



Once you have
pasted the
pattern together
you should have
all the pieces
shown to the
right



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Note that I colour coded the stitching holes so you know where everything goes.

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Start with the straps. Simple saddle stitch.



Next attach the side metal loop or the D ring holders. These are only necessary if you want to attach a shoulder strap.

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Time to attach the sides to the main piece.

Stitch the A piece on top of the side pieces like shown in the picture to the right



Last thing is attaching the strap. Best to screw in the button first and then make the hole for it so it closes the flap tightly.

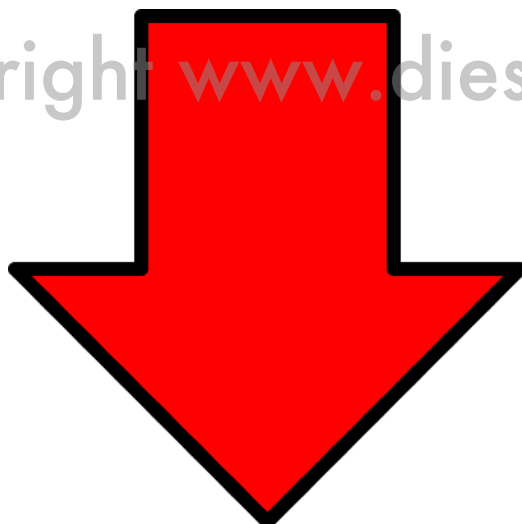
