- Every page has a measure - check does it fit.
- Every printed page **MUST HAVE** a border around! If doesn't - move paper left/ right

# YOU NEED

## TOOLS

- sharp knife
- hole puncher (1,2-1,5mm)  
or pricking irons or awl
  - hammer
  - 2 needles
- paper tape
  - ruler
- a printer

## MATERIALS

- Leather (preferable 4-5oz (2mm) and 7-8 oz (2,5-3mm) and 9oz (3,5mm) for arm strap
- Waxed thread (preferable 1 - 1,2mm)
  - 2 x 25mm d-rings
- 2 x brass/metal 20mm loop
  - 2 x 25mm loops
- 2 x 25mm snap hook
- 3 x 20mm belt buckles
- 1 x 25mm belt buckle
